

WINTHROP UNIVERSITY CREDIT - SCASP CONFERENCE WORKSHOPS -

1 Change in credit hours

To more closely align with actual “seat time,” WU has moved each SCASP full-day workshop from a 1.0 CEU credit to a more traditional **0.5 college semester credit**.

This still equates to **10 renewal credits** - see college credit on the [SCDE Renewal Credit Matrix](#).



4 Registration Steps

1. [Click here to register](#). If eligible for the 30% educator discount, please be sure to upload your Educator Certification.
2. Pay using the link emailed to you after registration.
3. Once payment is received, you will be registered.

Note: Please also register on SCASP’s [conference website](#) indicating you will be attending for WU credit.



2 Tuition and discount

The cost for each course used to be \$190. **Cost now aligns with graduate credit tuition** (currently \$213 for 0.5 credit).

BUT, you may request a **30% Educator Discount**, which then makes it less expensive than the previous rate.

Note: the senior discount no longer applies for these courses.

5 Getting your Transcript

Credit is added to transcripts at the end of each semester.

There is a fee for requesting transcripts so it is best to wait until your renewal is due before requesting it if you may take more courses.

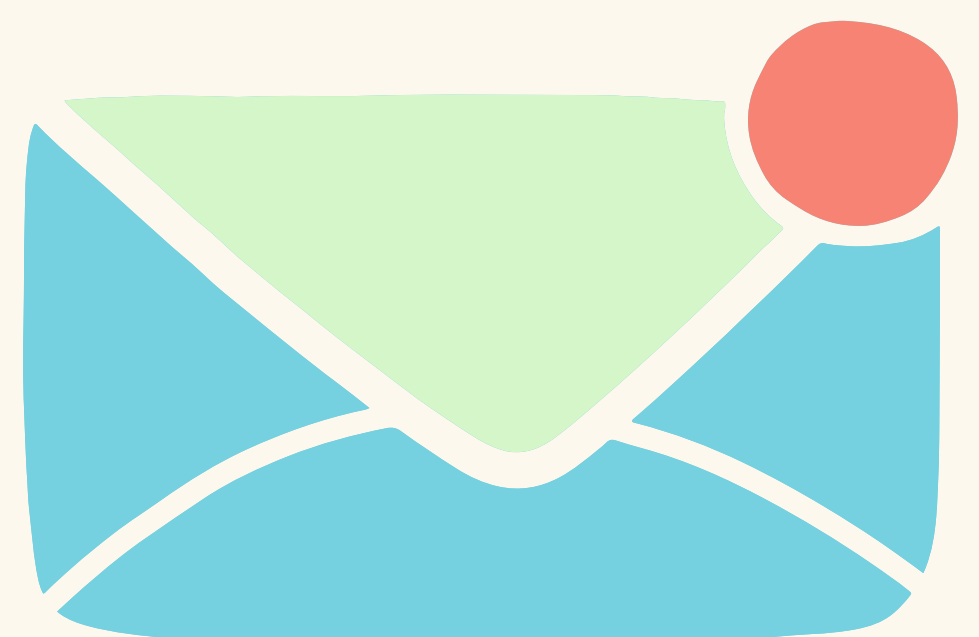

3 Information for retirees

SCDE now offers a Retired Educator Certificate that is a lifetime credential.

While retirees must submit a request every 5 years to keep their certification active, they are not held to renewal requirements, such as CPD credits.
